Dear Valued Client,

Spring is quickly approaching, and Nogas Landscaping is looking forward to servicing your Association in the upcoming season. Due to the relatively mild winter, we have gotten a jump start on a few spring services, and as weather permits, the crews will be on the properties performing additional pre-season services. The application of dormant oil on woody shrubs has begun and will be completed by mid-month. Core aerating will begin next week, and all properties will receive an initial fertilization application, containing a pre-emergent herbicide, for crabgrass. Furthermore, the time to most effectively combat apple scab in ornamental crabapples with the necessary fungicide applications, (minimum of two) is fast approaching. Spring is a great time to mulch existing landscape beds. We recommend mulching at least every two years. This encourages plant growth and also prevents several weeds from forming in beds without groundcover. Please consult Dave or Mike regarding walk throughs. A walk through will not only allow us to assess the property so that we may best care for it, but it will give you, the client, an opportunity to discuss any new ideas for landscaping design or concerns regarding landscape maintenance.
