Dear Valued Customer,

The presence of bagworms has been a major problem in the past and once present, will cause plant and tree death. Bagworms will feed on almost any leafy green tree or plant, which is why any activity should be actively noted. Please keep in mind, that we scout the property weekly in order to keep an active eye on any potential activity. Furthermore, the best time to spray for bagworms is when they are active, approximately May 15 to June 15. Enclosed is a brief article from the web explaining Bagworm control as well as our proposal for treatment of bagworms throughout the season. Be aware, that without effective identification and control of bagworms, mechanical removal may be necessary depending on the damage. We encourage you to read the attached information and respond as soon as possible in order to ensure the best possible service of your property.
