Due to the damaging draught conditions we have faced this Summer, you may wonder what kind of damage was incurred as a result of these poor weather conditions. We feel it is necessary to discuss and offer our professional services concerning the repair and renovation of your property's turf. Most lawn renovation can be achieved using the methods of core aerification, overseeding and slit seeding. This process entails aerifying the soil by making holes in the lawn, and using a slit-seeder to cut slits into existing grass and deposit new seed into the slits. This allows the turf to maintain the existing grass, while planting new seed as well without modifying the soil. This process is ideally conducted during late August or early September.

In order to ensure the best possible recovery for your property, the turf and property will need to be assessed to determine any damage. It is important to move quickly, so that the proper remedies can be applied at the most beneficial times. Nogas can identify the potential damage to your turf, and subsequently offer recovery services at an additional charge.
